HIKE DETAILS

The hike starts from Mill Farm, Chenies Bottom. You should be able to park near the farm. Take the A404 towards Chorleywood and turn left at the first sign for Chenies. You will pass the school on your left. Drive straight through the village centre and follow the road which bends to the left. **Do not turn right down Holloway Lane.** After the bend turn right and go over the bridge and Mill farm Barns is on the left. If you miss the turning you will be on Latimer Road going towards Latimer and Chesham. The public footpath we are following passes through the converted barns and along the river.
